ARTISTS & AVAILABLE ARTWORKS

Artrovert Gallery was founded by Siim Raie in 2022 and is located in the heart of Tallinn. The gallery operates a 200 m² white-cube exhibition space with a dynamic program that changes every six weeks, as well as a 300 m² showroom featuring works by over 80 artists — ranging from emerging talents to established names.

At ArtVilnius'25, we are proud to present the works of painter Eero Alev and printmaker Kadri Toom.

Estonian printmaker using de- and reconstruction as a method of self-expression



Kadri Toom is an Estonian printmaker who uses deconstruction and reconstruction as methods of self-expression. Her recent works are abstract, with hints of realism, but there's always a sense of mystery and an otherworldly playfulness in her surfaces. The focus is on exceptional quality.

Kadri's printmaking is experimental — far from traditional, both in scale and in colour, extending even to asymmetrical mountboards. She works with a variety of images, forms, technical drawings, and biological elements, blending them into layered prints and even collages. It's not only the subject matter that is deconstructed and reassembled; each layer is also printed using a different technique. She is a master of cyanotype, silkscreen, lithography, and, most recently, painted-paper collages — often combining three to four techniques in a single work. This approach creates a striking multi-dimensionality in her pieces. Her works are bold, both in colour and scale.

All of Kadri's works are unique and artist-printed (1/1, TPL'A). Although her chosen medium allows for printmaking in multiples, she creates only one of each image, preferring to work in series. Every piece is printed and developed entirely by the artist herself.

Kadri Toom graduated from the Painting Department of Tartu Art College in 2006 and received her MA in Printmaking from the Estonian Academy of Arts in 2009. She was awarded the Estonian Cultural Endowment Annual Award in 2022, named "Printmaker of the Year 2021" by the Association of Estonian Printmakers, and received an Encouragement Award in the Wiiralt Prize 2022 competition. She has participated in international residencies, art projects, and workshops, and has exhibited widely in Estonia and abroad. She is a member of both the Estonian Artists' Association and the Association of Estonian Printmakers.

In addition to being represented in numerous private collections, Kadri Toom's works were recently acquired by the Tartu Art Museum. Her recent exhibition *At the Height of Lightness* (April 30 – June 7, 2025) at Artrovert Gallery was a great success.

Eero Alev

1983

Estonian painter who has a strong element of realism in his works



Eero Alev is an Estonian painter whose practice centers on painting and drawing. His work is grounded in realism, though subtle deviations from strict representation often occur. Alev depicts spaces — both interior and exterior — as well as figures, particularly children. His style is rooted in traditional figurative techniques, but the subject matter is distinctly personal.

His paintings often explore themes of space and the human figure, childhood and memory, with a nuanced handling of colour that deepens the emotional tone of each work. Even when no figures are present, their absence is marked by traces — suggestions of presence. For Alev, the mood of a painting is paramount: loneliness, solitude, and a sense of longing are recurring elements in his work.

Fate, dreams, family, childhood, memory, and the search for meaning — these are the themes that occupy Alev's imagination. Nature, too, plays an essential role: both the experience of being immersed in it and the challenge of translating that experience onto canvas are central to his creative process.

Eero Alev holds both a bachelor's degree in Painting and a master's degree in Contemporary Art from the Estonian Academy of Arts. He currently teaches drawing and painting at the academy and works as a freelance artist. His works are represented in numerous private collections.

His recent solo exhibition *On the Horizon* (February 18 – March 22, 2025) at Artrovert Gallery was a great success.
